According to management these changes are a return to "industry standard policy". In fact, our current travel policy is in direct relation to the many concessions made during the CCAA process in 2003, concessions which members' working conditions still reflect.

Good labour relations are not achieved by management trying to use us as their piggy bank and trying to play us against each other through unequal travel policies.
